The panelists united with the supreme knight in sharing their powerful testimonies and insights of personal experiences relating to the atrocities that have occurred in the Middle East. **Now that genocide has been officially declared by U.S. Secretary of State John Kerry and world organizations as a result of such documentation as the nearly 300-page report produced by the Knights of Columbus, an appeal to the international community for concrete actions needed to help persecuted Christians was echoed by panelists.
